FEE PAYMENTS

All fees are due in Canadian Dollars (CAD) prior to the students arrival in Canada. Due dates for fees are indicated on the invoice.

DISCOUNTS

Golden Hills offers a discount to returning students, students with a Canadian passport, and families with more than one child in our program. Discount does not apply to short term applicants.

REFUND POLICY

Most fee payments are refundable if a student is denied entry to Canada.

The registration fee is nonrefundable and is due upon submission of the application.

There is an "Early Withdrawal Fee": \$1,250 (for non-emergent reasons).

MEDICAL INSURANCE

Medical insurance is mandatory for all students and will be purchased on their behalf by Golden Hills. All expenses not covered by the student's medical insurance are the responsibility of the student/parent and shall be paid directly to the authority from whom the cost originated (for example, Alberta Health Services). We encourage students and parents to review the insurance policy and consider supplemental medical insurance from their home country.

NOT INCLUDED

It is the student's responsibility to manage all other costs while attending a Golden Hills school, including:
